
## Psalm 103 Benedic, anima mea



- Bless the LORD, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy Name.
- 8 The <u>LORD</u> is full of compassion and <u>mercy</u>, <u>slow</u> to <u>anger</u> and of great <u>kindness</u>.
- 9 He will not <u>always</u> ac<u>cuse</u> us, <u>nor</u> will he keep his <u>anger</u> for <u>ever</u>.
- 10 <u>He</u> has not dealt with us ac<u>cording</u> to our <u>sins</u>, nor re<u>warded</u> us ac<u>cording</u> to our <u>wickedness</u>.
- 11 For as the heavens are <u>high</u> above the <u>earth</u>, <u>so</u> is his mercy <u>great</u> upon those who <u>fear</u> him.
- 12 As <u>far</u> as the <u>east</u> is from the <u>west</u>, <u>so</u> far has he re<u>moved</u> our <u>sins</u> from us.
- 13 <u>As</u> a father <u>cares</u> for his <u>children</u>, <u>so</u> does the <u>LORD</u> care for those who <u>fear</u> him.
- 14 <u>For</u> he himself <u>knows</u> whereof we are <u>made</u>; he re<u>members</u> that <u>we</u> are but <u>dust</u>.
